NOTICE: This handout is not a substitution for filing an official degree plan and is for faculty advising purposes only.

Instructions:

For the purposes of this assignment, your instructor wants you to assume that you plan to finish either an Associate of Arts (AA) or an Associate of Science (AS) degree. If you are formally in another program you can attach the appropriate paperwork to show that you met the objectives of the assignment.

Please select the appropriate degree plan (AA or AS) for your purposes from the following two pages. You do not need to fill out both. After completing the first worksheet, continue on to the “Course Planning Sheet” and fill-in when you plan to take future classes.

Note: The classes on the “Course Planning Sheet” should match the “Courses you plan to take” column from the worksheet.

The next two pages will be an example for a first semester student that plans to obtain an AA with an emphasis in Government.

About GOVT classes: In order to make it easier for students to transfer from a community college to a Texas public four-year college or university, the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board has adopted a new mandate that changes how the required six semester credit hours of Government courses will be taken. Formerly, there were two sequences of Government courses: GOVT 2301-2302 and GOVT 2305-2306. Beginning Fall semester 2013, only the GOVT 2305-2306 sequence will be offered by Texas community colleges. If you have only taken GOVT 2301, you may take either GOVT 2305 or 2306 to complete the sequence. If you have only taken GOVT 2302, you must take two of these three course options to complete the sequence: GOVT 2305, GOVT 2306, GOVT 2107.
